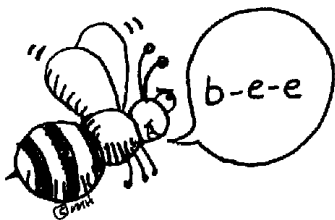

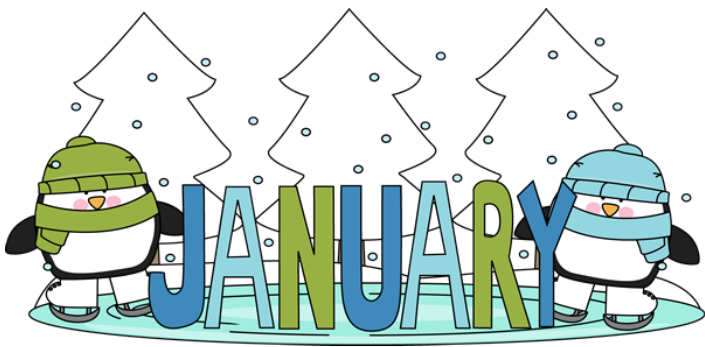
Pizza Making Fun

Don't forget on **Saturday, January 27th**, St. Paul School & Church will be making delicious homemade, FRESH pizzas! Parents, we will need all hands on deck to make this project a profitable one for our church and school. **There is a sign-up sheet in the school office. Please sign up so we know if we have to make phone calls to enlist more helpers.** Each of the last five years we made over 1,250 pizzas and had a profit of over \$4,000, and with about 60 helpers we finished making the pizzas in 3½ hours. The more workers we have, the less time is needed. Order forms were due to be handed in this Friday January 12th, however the **final cutoff date** to hand the forms in **has been extended to Friday January 19th**. This will allow you to get more orders this weekend. Payment at time of ordering is encouraged, but not required. **Don't forget to print your name and most important your phone number on the space provided, so if you are not present when your order is ready, we can call you. Also list the students name so we have a record of the number of pizzas they sold.** This year we will again be awarding Chamber Cash Gift Cards for the students who sell the most pizzas. First place will receive a \$25 Gift Card and second place will receive a \$20 Gift Card. This has turned out to be a fun event bringing people from church and school working side by side and getting to know one another.

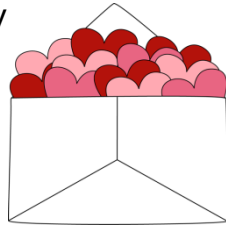
