## Fall School Immunization Reminder

Will your child be starting Kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup> grade, high school or even college next fall? This summer will be an excellent time to have them visit their health care provider for an exam and to provide the **needed vaccines** required for school. While the kids are out of school, it is much easier to arrange for them to receive these required vaccines. If you plan to do it early in the summer, you avoid the rush before classes start in the fall. Most insurance policies now cover well child exams and vaccines. Bring a copy of their new vaccines to school so the staff can update their school records.

**Now is the time to talk to your provider about the required and recommended vaccines for your child.**

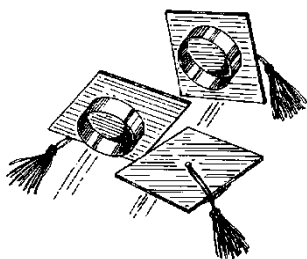
