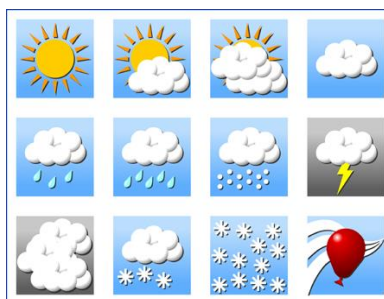
Star Wars: Shakespeare Edition
