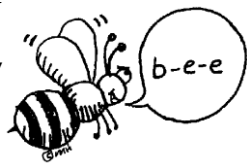

Also list the students name so we have a record of the number of pizzas they sold.** This year we will again be awarding Chamber Cash Gift Cards for the students who sell the most pizzas. First place will receive a \$25 Gift Card and second place will receive a \$20 Gift Card. This has turned out to be a fun event bringing people from church and school working side by side and getting to know one another.

Amazing Facts for the Faithful

Read these interesting tidbits and see how many times you can say, "I knew that."

- The word "Lord" appears at least 7,670 times in the Bible.
- The only bald man mentioned in the Bible is Elisha (2 Kings 2:23).
- Noah's wife is mentioned five times in the Book of Genesis, but never by name. Other famous nameless biblical women include Lot's wife, and the daughter of Herodias.
- Esther is the first book in the Bible that doesn't mention God. The second is the Song of Solomon.
- Only two angels are mentioned by name in the Bible: Gabriel and Michael.
- The shortest verse in the Bible is two words long: "Jesus wept" (John 11:35).
- Some scholars believe Jesus was 5' 6" – four inches taller than the average Middle Eastern male of Old Testament times.
- "Amazing Grace" has been recorded by more performers than any other song.
- If you've read 2 Kings 19, you know what Isaiah 37 says. They're almost identical.
- Scholars say nine modern fruits were eaten 2,000 years *before* Christ: grapes, pears, quinces, watermelon, figs, dates, bananas, apricots and apples.
- The smallest church in the world designated as a cathedral is Christ Catholic Church in Highlandville, MO. It seats 18.
