Next week there will be NO School on Wednesday. However, Alleluia Choir sings Wednesday night at the 6:30 Thanksgiving service.

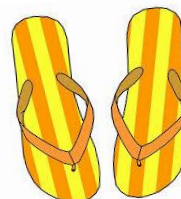
Break the Dress Code

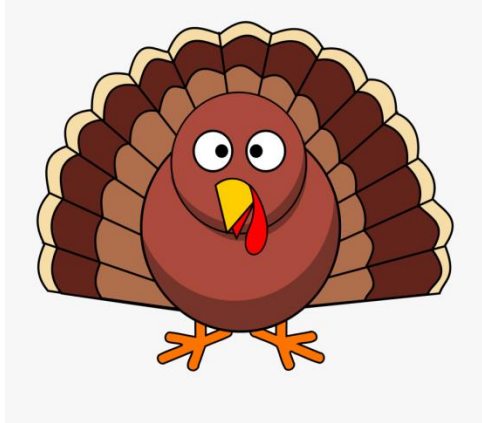
